A strong field of 59 players graced the Branxton fairways on a very hot summer's day. Kelvin Mather, teeing off rather late around lunch time, defied the hot weather to win the Monthly Medal with an outstanding 63 nett, Kelvin has been playing excellent golf recently with this round no exception to his latest efforts. the 2017 Club Champion, Joshua Tracey, showed his class by winning the A Grade competition with an outstanding 64 nett from his near scratch handicap. This 5-6 under par round is similar to his effort to win last year's Branxton Open and easily win the Club Championships—he is certainly starting to play to his early potential. Peter Wilton, one of the club's most consistent golfers for many years, finished runner up with an excellent 68 nett from his low handicap, with Troy McCaw finishing third , on a countback, with his 69. Troy has really settled into playing in A Grade quite easily during this last year, with many excellent results over the last 12 months. Steve Ross won B Grade with his 68 nett score, indicating that the school holidays are certainly agreeing with him. Joe Bereza finished runner up with his 69 nett, with Gary Walsh's 71 nett good enough for third. His round included a nearest the pin on the very difficult 13th hole. Barry Turner turned it on once again to win C Grade with his 66 nett score, just ahead of the duo of Peter Marquet and John Martin who both had a 67 nett score. A 73 nett score was needed to win a ball with the day's DSR rating a 68.
