The 2018 Club Championships started last weekend, with the first two rounds played on Saturday and Sunday, with the last two rounds scheduled for next weekend. Over 70 starters participated with high hopes for all competitors. On Saturday, Bob Biles won the A Grade Stableford with an excellent 39 pts, just missing breaking the 80 mark with a close putt on the last. Daniel Turner also had 39 pts to finish second, demonstrating some great improvement with his game after some recent lessons, whilst Ken Hush came third with his pleasing 36 pts. Cameron Johanson took the first round lead in the championship with a 73 off the stick, coming home strongly after a 4 over front nine. Isiah Wolferstan was in second place only 2 shots behind, with last year's champion Joshua Tracey third with his 77. Robert Hale showed what he could do with an outstanding 42 pts to win B Grade on a countback from Mick Barrett, with Paul Bush third with his excellent 40 pts. Mick took the first round lead with his 80 off the stick, two shots clear of Bob's 82. Mick Carling had a great day, winning C Grade with his 38 pts, just ahead of Richard Alley and Peter Matthews with the same scores. It looks like the C Grade championship could go down to the wire. The shots of the day belonged to Steve Ross with two nearest the pins, including a wonderful shot to the 9th, finishing only 18 cms away.

The second round of the Club Championship continued on Sunday—a much cooler day for all golfers. David Matt won A Grade with an excellent 39 pts, from Cameron Johanson's and Lee Hunt's 37 pts. Lloyd Barrett won B Grade with his 39 pts, again on a countback from Peter Marquet, with Daniel Rogers a stroke further back. Eddie Neale took the honours in C Grade with his 36 pts, just ahead of Mick Lutovac and John Martin. The shot of the day belonged to Isiah Wolferstan on the 2nd/11th, finishing just over a metre from the cup. After the completion of two rounds of the Club Championship, Cameron Johanson has opened up a commanding 8 stroke lead in A Grade, after his wonderful par round of 70 on Sunday. (143 two round total). Cameron is based at the Killara Golf Club during the week but plays most weekends back home at Branxton, having started his golf at this club. Isiah Wolferstan and Joshua Tracey are his nearest rivals, with this talented trio set for some wonderful golf next weekend. Robert Hale has held his lead after two days in B Grade with a 169 total, after his 82 and 87 rounds, with a host of players hot on his tail. Peter Mathews is the leader in C Grade on 185, with many players not too far back.
